### Summer Policy:

**MUST enroll for the entire summer camp (11 weeks).** No late starts or early withdraws. The deposit will be applied the last week of summer. If you register for summer and then pull out you will not receive your summer deposit back and your child(ren) will be removed from the fall rosters and put on the bottom of the waiting list. If your child is a summer only enrollee and you pull them before the summer ends you will not be able to attend the next summer.

### Payment Policy:

**Tuition is due the FIRST DAY of the week your child is scheduled.** We operate on a "FLAT FEE" schedule. Weekly tuition remains the same even if the center is closed for a holiday. If your account falls more than two (2) weeks behind, without previous arrangements with the Administrator, your child may be dismissed from the center.

**Hours of Operation:** 6:00a.m.-6:00p.m.

**Meals served:** Breakfast, Morning Snack, Lunch and Afternoon Snack. **BCLC is a nut-free facility.**

We care for children 2 1/2 years and potty-trained through 5th grade.



Our fall session starts the middle of August and we provide Preschool, Pre-K, All Day Kindergarten and Before and After School care for 1st - 5th grade. Additional information is available upon request.

Field trips must be paid in advance prior to the start of the summer session.

## ***Kindergarten and School Age Program***

Kindergarten students will not be promoted to 1st grade for the summer program.

*All Kindergarten and School Age students must be enrolled for 3 to 5 full days due to the summer field trip schedule.* We have weekly themes to keep the summer months fun and exciting. No field trips are scheduled on Mondays or Fridays. We offer a combination of on-site and off-site field trips such as:
