

Beavercreek Christian Learning Center Before/After Care School Age Program

We offer a before and/or after program for Kindergarten through 5th grade children attending Beavercreek Public Elementary Schools and St. Luke Elementary. Our main objective at BCLC is to provide quality care with a structured environment for your child. We provide the following; teacher led activities, daily devotional and prayers, ample amount of time to complete homework, daily gym/outside time, weekly chapel, and arts and crafts.

When schools are closed due to bad weather, teacher in-service or scheduled holidays we accommodate the students full day, without any additional fees. For planned closings, we post RSVP forms on each class clipboard for you to indicate if your child will be in attendance. This helps us staff accordingly. If schools are delayed, we can only accommodate students who are signed up for before care.

Children will be transported privately through BCLC buses (with the exception of Main Elementary, which buses students separately.) If students who are scheduled to be picked up by BCLC are not present, BCLC checks with the school official on premise for the child's whereabouts. For this reason, **it is very important that parents contact the center when their child is not going to be attending.**

To maintain safety, children are to adhere to the following Bus Rules:

- Stay seated with your seat belt tightly fastened.
- Remain in your seat until the bus has come to a complete stop.
- Talking voices only – no screaming or yelling.
- Backpack items remain in your backpack.
- No food, drinks or candy permitted to be eaten on the bus.

If students do not adhere to the bus rules and multiple warnings have been given/parents contacted, BCLC reserves the right to revoke busing privileges for that student. Riding privileges can be removed completely for that student if the undesired behavior persists. We appreciate your support in helping us enforce safety.

SAMPLE OF BEFORE AND/OR AFTER SCHOOL AGE SCHEDULE

Morning Sample Schedule for all children

6:30-7:45	Gym time for all ages- if the number of students exceed two class sizes (36 kids), students will be taken to the classroom to do quiet activities (reading, homework, board games etc.)
7:45	BCLC buses depart for Parkwood and Shaw. <u>Students must be present no later than 7:40am if they are to ride on the bus to Parkwood and Shaw!</u>
7:45-8:10	Children continue to play in gym and/or classroom
8:10:8:20	Kids wash hands
8:25	Main bus departs. <u>Main kids must be at BCLC no later than 8:15am.</u>
8:30	Trebein, Valley and Fairbook buses depart. <u>This students must be in the center no later than 8:15. Once the BCLC buses leave, students cannot be dropped off.</u>

Afternoon Sample Schedule for Parkwood and Shaw students

3:10-3:20	Children arrive from Parkwood and Shaw Elementary School
3:20-3:45	Restroom, Handwashing
3:45-4:30	Homework and or/quiet reading, Activity packets and free play given upon completion of homework. Daily devotionals.
4:30-5:00	Gym or outside time
5:00-5:30	Teacher directed activities, open free play (board games, puzzles) Extra homework time will be given if needed.
5:30-5:40	Final Meeting- pack bags, review day, messages, clean room. Children brought over to office area around 5:40 for departure.

Afternoon Sample Schedule for Trebein, Main, Fairbrook and Valley students

4:00-4:10	Children arrive from Trebein, Main, Fairbrook and Valley
4:10-4:30	Restroom, Handwashing
4:30-5:00	Teacher directed activities, open free play (board games, puzzles) Extra homework time will be given if needed.
5:00-5:35	Gym or outside time
5:35-5:40	Final Meeting- pack bags, review day, messages, clean room. Children brought over to office area around 5:40 for departure.
